

## Japan Radio Law: High-Frequency Devices<sup>\*1</sup>

High-Frequency Devices (HFDs) are specified in Article 46 of the Radio Law's Enforcing Regulations. HFPs are subject to 3 kinds of approval and must be registered by a local representative with the relevant regional branch of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications (MIC) for their business address.



JQA can conduct relevant testing and register the product with MIC on behalf of your local representative (with a letter of authorization). Products subject to HFD approval may also be subject to EMC and safety testing under the PSE Mark. JQA can offer a volume discount for applicants requiring for PSE and HFD testing at the same time.
